The Truth About Laser Treatments for Onychomycosis

Nail fungus or onychomycosis can be embarrassing as nails discolor, thicken and separates from the nail bed. It affects approximately 10% of the population worldwide. Some people are more susceptible, and at an increased risk. The organisms that cause onychomycosis thrive in wet, dark, warm places, anytime these conditions exist, the risk of developing onychomycosis increases. Treatments for onychomycosis include oral, topical, and laser treatments.

Oral Medications

Oral medications are less than 50% effective, can cause side effects and have interactions with other medications. Side effects can include gastrointestinal upset, liver damage, or kidney damage.

Topical Medications

Topical medications like ciclopirox nail solution are less than 10% effective. This nail lacquer requires daily application for 48 weeks and weekly removal by filing each nail. Other topical treatments like tea tree oil, Vicks vapor rub do NOT work.

Laser Treatment

Laser treatment of onychomycosis has no downtime, or side effects. A resent study showed 51% of the nails treated were completely cleared and tested negative for fungal infection, 81% of the nails treated showed complete to moderate clearing. In our office I am seeing these numbers significantly increase with our new parameters.

The Laser Treatment

Depending on the severity of the nail infection, nails may require debridement prior to laser treatment. During the laser treatment a patient will experience a gentle warming sensation, if the warming becomes uncomfortable, the operator moves on to other nails.

At totally feet podiatry and laser center we use the latest most effective laser and a long term approach. Our new improved treatment protocol is achieving increased efficacy clinically.

Long-Term Prevention

It is important to sanitize shoes, socks, showers, bedding, and other potential sources of reinfection. Some people may re-

quire periodic follow up treatments to establish desired results. People that are more susceptible to onychomycosis may require a topical preventative nail treatment like Formula 3. New nail growth should be clear, it takes an average of 9-12 months for the nail to completely regrow. We educate patients on the expected outcomes and preventative
